Gospel-Shaped Giving

Expanded Scripture Handout to Accompany 1 Corinthians 16:1–12

Big Idea

Because Christ has given Himself for us, gospel-shaped love makes us available to help with our giving, our planning, and our support for others. In 1 Corinthians 16:1–2, Paul highlights three enduring principles of Christian giving: it is regular ('on the first day of every week'), proportionate ('as he may prosper'), and purposeful ('for the saints'). These reflect the broader pattern of Scripture from Israel's worship to the life of the early church.

Putting It Into Practice

- Make giving a weekly worship rhythm (plan it; pray over it).
- Aim for proportionate generosity... start with a wise baseline (e.g., a tithe), and grow as God prospers you.
- Give purposefully: toward your local church, gospel workers, and real needs among the saints.
- Remember: God cares about the heart (2 Cor 9:7). He sees the widow's two coins (Mark 12:41–44).
